SHERWOOD SOUTH ANIMAL HOSPITAL BOARDING AGREEMENT

We are very pleased that you have entrusted us with the care of your pet(s) while you are away. The following information will help ensure everything is in order for his/her stay.

When your pet arrives at our hospital, we will remove and return to you any collars/leashes or other personal items. We will immediately attach an I.D. band with your name and your pet's name.

Your pet will be inspected for fleas/ticks or other **external parasites**. If any parasites are found, your pet will be treated before entering our boarding facility at your expense. Pets who become ill while boarding will be treated at the discretion of the veterinarian of staff at the client's expense. We will attempt to contact you at the emergency number to discuss any illnesses that may be noted or arise during boarding.

PROOF OF VACCINATIONS: All pets must be current on vaccinations to enter the boarding facility. This ensures your pet's protection, as well as ensuring the safety of our other boarders as well. We must have written or faxed documentation by a veterinarian. The required vaccines include: **DOGS: DA₂PLCPV/CV** (7in1), **Bordetella** (kennel cough) every 6 (six) months, **Rabies Vaccine** (required yearly by East Baton Parish law). **CATS: FVRCP** (3in1 or 4in1), **Rabies Vaccine** (required yearly by East Baton Parish law), **FLV** is recommended for any cat that goes outdoors but is not required for boarding.

PERSONAL ITEMS: Clean bedding will be provided for all pets boarding with us. We understand the desire to leave personal bedding with your pet, but due to cleanliness issues, we prefer to use our own bedding unless special needs of a pet's illness require other bedding to be used (orthopedic conditions, etc.). Any personal items left with pets must be labeled very plainly with permanent marker. **SHERWOOD SOUTH ANIMAL HOSPITAL AND BOARDING RESORT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGED OR LOST PERSONAL ITEMS LEFT WITH PETS.** Your pets boarding area is cleaned thoroughly **every** day (or more often if needed) and all bedding is changed and washed. Some bedding brought from home may not hold up to these conditions and may become damaged.

SPECIAL FOOD OR MEDICATIONS: Unless personal food is brought, your pet will be fed Science Diet dry food according to his/her age/size/etc. We will be happy to feed any food that is brought with your pet. Please leave feeding instruction with the food. Any medications your pet may need will also be given by our support staff. Please leave very detailed instructions with medications and the time the next dose is to be given.

LUXURY SUITE POLICY: Sherwood South Animal Hospital has the right to refuse luxury suite usage for pets who are difficult to handle or become unruly while boarding in our suites. If while boarding in the luxury suites, your pet becomes destructive, he/she will be removed from the suites and placed in an appropriate location. Owners will be held responsible for the replacement value of any damage incurred.

BATHING: It is recommended that all dogs receive a bath before going home. Pet hair attracts odor easily and even the cleanest dogs may pick up odors. The charge for bathing is additional and will range from \$14.00-\$25.00 depending on the size pet/hair length (please ask about the price for your pet). Bathing includes a pedicure and ear cleaning. Extra de-matting or grooming is not included in this price.
